



Monongahela Farmers' Market, Monongahela, Pennsylvania Market **FOOD TRUCKS & BOOTHS Operations Application and Rules**

Location, Hours, and Season

The Monongahela Farmers' Market will be held, rain or shine, each **Friday** afternoon from **3:00pm to 6:00pm**, running 17 weeks beginning **June 5th** and continuing through **September 25th**. The Market is held in historic Monongahela and is located right along Main Street on Seventh Street (Farmers) and in Chess Park.

Fees and Spaces for Food Trucks and Booths

The available space will be as follows: 10 by 10 space in Chess Park or ONE (1) parking space at either 7th Street or Chess Street behind the park (the committee will determine your location). If your food truck is towed by another vehicle, you will need to reserve 2 spaces. The cost is \$350 for the full 17 weeks or \$125 for 4 Fridays, or \$40 for a single Friday. If you are in need of electricity, it will be an additional \$5 per week, and will be awarded on a first come/first served basis. You are responsible for providing all electrical cords. It is suggested that you have at least a 75 foot extension cord available. Please reserve the space you require. Spaces are limited and there is no guarantee that everyone will receive the number of spaces requested in their application. Spaces will be awarded on a first come/first served. No vendors should have children under 16 selling at their space without adult supervision. You are responsible for taking any trash from your area to the dumpster located at the side alley (opposite 7th Street). **STAKING OF TENTS OR ANYTHING ELSE INTO THE GROUND WITHIN CHESS PARK IS ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED.** Violation of this rule will be an immediate termination of your contract with no refund and you will be asked to leave the property. Please understand that this is a City of Monongahela rule which will be strictly enforced.

Food Vendors are required to have all current state and local inspection and licenses (City of Monongahela has its own health inspector. If you prepare your food at the Farmers' Market, **YOU WILL BE INSPECTED BY THE CITY'S HEALTH INSPECTOR**, which is good for an entire year anywhere in the City of Monongahela), including but not limited to all Serv Safe requirements. There will be no fee from the City for this

inspection as we are a non-profit. They will not inspect you unless you are at the Market for 4 or more Fridays.

Participation

Set up begins at 1:30 pm. Please see the MARC staff for your location. If you are a full season vendor, your location will not change. Please be ready by 2:45 pm and there is no selling before 3:00 pm or when the MARC representative opens the market. Please do not arrive prior to 1:30 pm unless prior arrangements have been made.

Attendance

Vendors are expected to attend at least 15 of the 17 Market days for those who have chosen to attend the entire season. You are required to give advance notice of the days when they intend not to come in order to permit the Market to better accommodate their absence. Advance notice is no later than 10:00 am on Thursday. *If you miss 2 Fridays with no or late notice, you will forfeit your space and will receive no refund.*

For vendors selecting specific Fridays, there will be no refunds for no-shows or cancellations. The no show/late notice also applies to those who choose other multiple Fridays also. Understand, we work very hard to advertise extensively for the Market and if we advertise your business is going to be there, and you no show/no call, the committee is the one who gets the negative feedback.

Operating Agency

The Market is operated by the Monongahela Farmers' Market Committee. Monongahela Area Revitalization Corp (MARC) is the designated Market Coordinator. Most Market activities are performed by volunteers and MARC may delegate much of their powers and duties to those Market volunteers as they deem advisable. Inclement Weather

The Market Committee will determine if the market will open or close early due to inclement weather. We are a rain, shine or wind event. If there is lightning in the area, the market will close. You are required to pack up and vacate the premises immediately. Failure to do so will void your contract.
